Book Jacket Book Report

For this book report, you will create a book cover that displays the dystopian elements of the book you have just read. Follow the directions below to complete the jacket. Take pride in your work. Use your best penmanship, add color and pictures, edit for spelling and grammar errors, and pay particular attention to your word choice. Neatness counts!

How to Make a Book Jacket:

- 1. Congratulations you have been chosen to create the new release cover for your novel. You will be creating the front and back covers of the book.
- 2. As an artist you will need to create a large scale cover so we can shrink it down for better resolution. (Poster size)
- 3. Spend some time looking over other released covers of your novel. What did they focus on, what was the dominant image, how did it make you feel, what was its mood, etc.

Putting It All Together

Front Cover: On the front cover you need to include the title of the book, the author's name, and an interesting cover that represents the dystopian elements found within your novel.

Back Cover: On the back cover write a summary of the events in the book. Remember, the summary <u>states</u> the facts, <u>not</u> what you thought about the book. The summary should focus on analyzing the dystopian elements in the novel and how the characters overcome these oppressions. On the lower half of the cover include interesting quotes from the book that support how the characters overcame their dystopian world.

***Use the Dystopian reference sheet to help guide your project.

Remember both covers should be poster size as to really show off the detail. Any medium of art is accepted. Think about how to represent something visually without it being too representational.
